The EMS coverage begins Wed. August 25th at noon and ends September 7th at 5p.m.

We have a clinic set up 7 days a week 24 hours a day.

We work closely with Mat-Su EMS in providing transportation and other services

We average between 300 to 1000 patients, 9 to 27 transports over the 14 day period.

We see Trauma and Medical issues, some pre-existing and others new.

Benefits:

Food is provided while on shift

Receive free secured parking for the day you work and the additional day you return

Ticket for YOURSELF and one other on the day YOU volunteer

A place for you to sleep and shower if staying overnight

Transportation daily from and too Anchorage, Eagle River etc.

Ticket for YOURSELF and one other with free parking again on another day of YOUR choice

We furnish all supplies and equipment except for YOUR personal items and basic ems gear (shears, note pad, etc.). Anything you may need to stay overnight you will need to provide (sleeping bag, etc).

Uniforms consist of volunteers in leather shoes, slacks (not jeans), long sleeve shirt and other items needed for possible weather issues.
